**GUIDELINES**

There is no entry fee.

The entry form requires all youth artists, parents or school representatives to attest that the student is able to show tribal affiliation in accordance with Public law 101-644 (104 Stat. 4662, Act of 11/29/90) with one of the following:

- a. Tribal Membership card; or
- b. Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood; or
- c. Official Document certifying Indian Artisan; or
- d. Federal, State, or Tribal document establishing Indian lineage.

Limited to one (1) entry per artist per category. No limit on number of categories per artist.

Group projects will not be accepted – individual artists only.

Artwork must be delivered in person by artist, parent, or teacher.

Red Earth will not accept mailed entries.

All entries must be display-ready (ex: hooks for hanging)

**NOTE:** Discount Festival tickets will be available at Check-In to gain entry to the Sunday Awards and Art Pick-Up. Adult \$7.50 - Child \$5 - Children 5 and under Free.

Entering of the same artwork that won awards at a prior Red Earth Art competition is prohibited.

Artwork must be checked in between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Thursday, June 17, 2010.

Winners will be announced and awards presented at the Award Ceremony on Sunday, June 20, 2010.

Artwork must be picked-up between 3 p.m. and 4 p.m. on Sunday, June 20, 2010.

Red Earth is not responsible for unclaimed artwork. Red Earth, Inc. is not responsible for items lost or damaged during exhibition.

Student artists entering the Red Earth Youth Art Competition are prohibited from entering the Adult Art Competition. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification from both of the competitions.
