I understand I may be asked to provide document of (1) proof of membership in a federally or state-recognized tribal entity; or (2) proof of certification as Indian Artisan by an Indian tribe.

In signing this agreement form I understand that all my sales at the Red Earth Spring Art Market are subject to a 9.333% sales tax. Artists, who do not have an Oklahoma Sales Tax Permit, must submit sales tax to Red Earth prior to move-out. A tax form will be provided in your artist packet.

SPRING ART MARKET

Eligibility and Guidelines

APPLICATION DEADLINE MONDAY, APRIL 6, 2020

Red Earth is currently accepting applications for the new Red Earth Spring Market, scheduled for Saturday April 18, 2020. Red Earth will showcase Native art in an Arts & Crafts Market on the lawn overlooking the City of Claremore and Rogers State University. We are looking forward to a beautiful spring day and hope it can become a regular event in northeast Oklahoma.

ARTIST ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be 19 years of age or older at the time of application.
- Must provide proof of tribal affiliation in a federally or state-recognized tribal entity.
- If selected, must displaying for sale **original, hand-made** art and art objects.
- New artists who have not participated in prior Red Earth markets must provide digital images of items to be sold in booth space along with a sample photo of booth set up. Submit images via email to info@redearth.org or by mail to Red Earth, 100 N. Broadway #2750, Oklahoma City, OK 73102.
- Will submit a completed and signed application along with booth and equipment fees. Payment may be made by check, money order or credit card via online at www.redearth.org/artists.

BOOTH AND DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

- Booth space is \$50 per unit and is available in two sizes and is sold on a first-come-first-serve basis:
 - 8 ft wide by 6 ft deep space on the Museum South Porch (no tents allowed)
 - 10 ft by 10 ft Tent spaces on the lawn. No logo tents allowed.
- There is no storage space available outside your assigned booth space.
- Artists are responsible for their own tent structures, canopies, racks, displays, chairs and dollies. All display materials must be suitable for outdoor use.
- Rental tables are available if ordered in advance. Quantities are limited.
- Artists are responsible for the cleanup of all trash. All trash bags must be removed and put in the dumpster or taken off site.
- Artists must provide weights to secure tents/canopies in the event of wind or inclement weather. Tent weights may be fashioned by buckets filled with cured concrete. No staking tents into ground and no sand is allowed. All materials must be removed and taken with you when you leave.

SPRING ART MARKET SCHEDULE – SATURDAY APRIL 18:

7 am to 9 am	Artist unloading and move-in
10 am to 5 pm	Spring Art Market Open to the Public
5 pm to 6 pm	Artist move-out and load out

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GUIDELINES:

- Artists working in most mediums will be considered.
- Only original works created by the selected artist may be sold in his/her booth.
- No sharing or subletting booth space.
- No stores or dealers.
- Artist agrees to be present in their booth during the public hours of the Market. You may have family or friends assist you.
- All artwork must be handmade and not commercially or factory produced.
- Artists may NOT display or sell any items that contain materials derived from animals which are considered endangered or might otherwise be considered in violation of Federal or Oklahoma state laws. Sale or display of prehistoric, ceremonial objects or culturally sensitive artifacts is prohibited.
- No animals are allowed in booths, except service dogs.
- It is the responsibility of the artist to maintain adequate insurance coverage for possessions and property in booth. Red Earth will not be responsible for any loss due to theft, accident or act of nature.
- All work must be properly represented to the buyer. All items displayed must be for sale and clearly priced. All artwork must bear the hallmark (**signature, mark or stamp**) of the artist.
- Red Earth reserves the right to assign artist location in the best interest of the Festival and reassign booths due to cancellations or no-shows.
- All sales at the Red Earth Spring Art Market are subject to a 9.333% sales tax. Artists who do not have an Oklahoma Sales Tax Permit, must submit sales tax payment to Red Earth prior to move-out on Saturday, April 18, 2020. A Sales Tax Payment Form will be provided in your artist packet.
- Red Earth will not issue refunds for any fees paid in connection with this event.
