- Editing of short videos for arts and education program
- Revise existing videos to ensure high quality and consistent presentation of Red Earth brand.
- Dissemination of information about the Red Earth programs, exhibitions, and educational programs to appropriate audiences

- Basic use of single camera video production equipment.
- Basic proficiency with Adobe Creative Cloud video editing software.
- Completed or working toward a college degree, Course experience in video production desirable.
- Communications, Film/Video Production, Graphic Design, Visual Arts.
- Related experience in video production is a plus
- Self-motivated, good organizational skills, detail-oriented, ability to prioritize, multi-task and meet deadlines.
